What would it look like to genuinely pray for God's kingdom to come and His will to be done in your family and the families in our church? We want to encourage you to receive, reflect, and pray over Scripture each week throughout the month of October. Take moments during the week to marinate in the Word and commune with God. He loves to hear His people pray. Not just for ourselves, but for others as well. May His kingdom come, and His will be done in our families and in our church family!

Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Acts 17:24–28.

God, in His sovereign purposes, has placed you in your family and has a unique role for you to play in His kingdom. Take moments this week to thank God for your family and ask God to bless them and allow His kingdom to come and will to be done in their hearts and lives. Pray for God to reveal Himself to family members, to have His way in their life, and to bring them to a saving and growing knowledge of Jesus. If it is difficult to pray for your family, ask God for the courage and the grace to do so and thank Him for the church family He has provided for you.



WEEK 2 Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over 1 Corinthians 13 and Galatians 5:22-26. Pray this

week that God would fill your family members with His love and His Spirit. Pray for grace to wholeheartedly love the family (and the church family) that God has placed you in and provided for you. Pray that His love will be both received and displayed in your home and in your family relationships and ask for it to begin in you.

Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over

Ephesians 4:31–32. As you pray this week, pray for unity and peace within your family. When God's kingdom truly comes in relationships, forgiveness is both given and received. Reconciliation is possible. Ask God to help you be a peacemaker in your family. Realize that, in Christ, God has forgiven you, and this love makes it possible for you to forgive others.

Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over

Joshua 24:15. Pray that Christ will be the center of your family and that His agenda would be top priority. Confess competing agendas and commit yourself to serving the Lord with your whole heart. Pray that this will be true for your entire family and our church family.
