Too much of a good thing isn't always a good thing. (Proverbs 25:27-28)

Just because technology can be used to glorify God doesn't mean we still shouldn't be wise in how we use it or how much we use it. (1 Cor. 6:12; 10:23)

- I love that I can connect with people all over the world...make sure you're enjoying the people God has put in front of you every day.
- I love that I can capture and share moments in time with people I love... make sure you're enjoying your life as much as you are trying to capture it.
- I love that there are digitized versions of many things that only used to be physical...make sure you're still engaging the physical universe God made around you and not just the man-made filtered version of it.
- I love that I can keep up with all of the latest information and news without having to watch the news all day...make sure you are spending time "out of the loop" hearing and seeing what God wants you to, and not just what your digital feed wants you to.
- I love that I can be productive in one area of life, while waiting for important information in another area of life...make sure that you understand there is no such thing as true "multi-tasking" and strive to engage things fully when possible.

At the end of the day, just remember, there is a time to engage with technology and a time to put it away...too much of a good thing is not always a good thing. (Eccl. 3:1-8)
