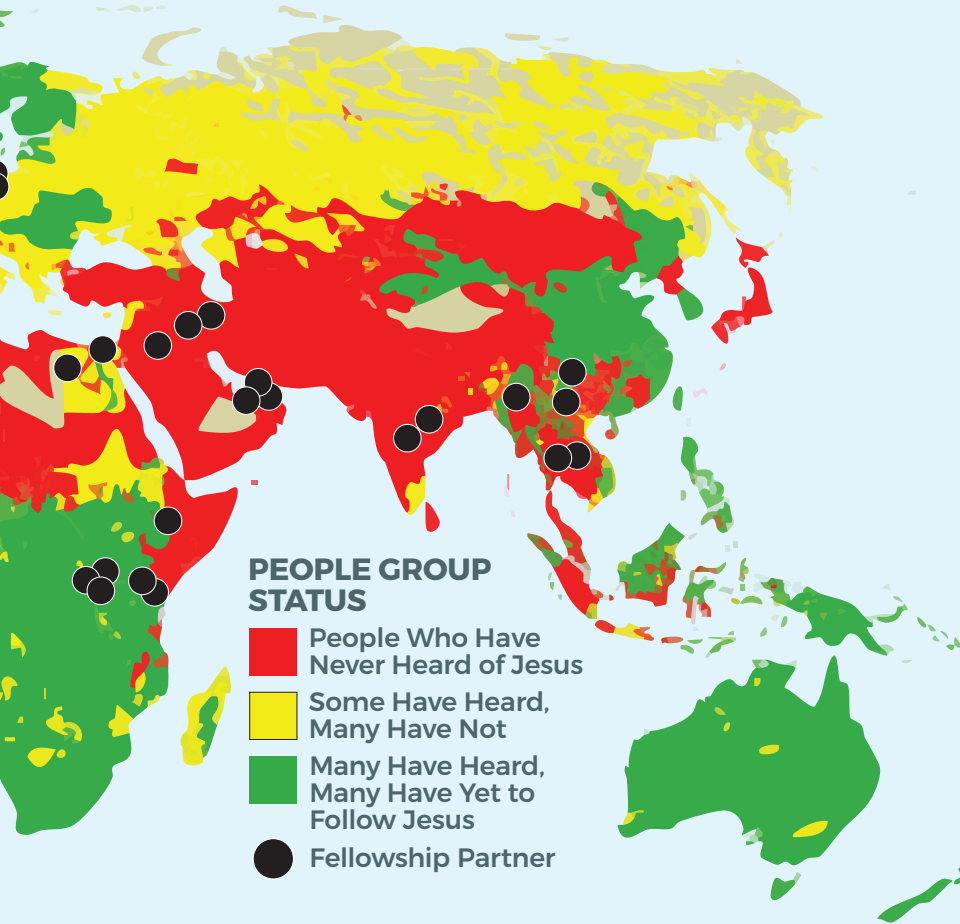

LET'S PRAY!

Unreached People Groups

More than 2.9 billion people in the world are unreached and need to be simply introduced to Jesus. Yet there are billions more who also do not believe in Jesus, as their personal Lord and Savior. Many of these groups have little or no access to the gospel or a healthy local church.

Throughout Scripture, God reveals His heart for all nations to know Him and enjoy Him forever. In His loving sovereignty, God commands and empowers us, the Church, to go and declare His grace and glory across the nations, so that a knowledge of His saving power and glory will fill the Earth. As a church and as believers in Jesus, it is our mission to live out the Great Commission and share the gospel not only here at home, but across the world.

United Arab Emirates (Dubai)

- Total people groups identified: **44**
- Unreached people groups: **36 (approx. 82%)**
- Population living in unreached groups: **~8.4 M (75% of the country's population)**

Kenya

- Total people groups: **105**
- Unreached people groups: **29 (approx. 28%)**
- Population in unreached groups: **~5.4 M (~9% of the population)**

Thailand

- Total people groups identified: **109**
- Unreached people groups: **72 (approx. 66%)**

India

Pray for All Unreached People Groups

- Pray that every unreached people group would have the chance to hear about Jesus—through friends, Scripture, churches, or believers sent to them.
- Pray for the Bible to be translated and shared in every language, so people can hear God's Word in a way they understand.
- Pray for hearts to be open—that fear, tradition, or barriers would not keep people from responding to the gospel.
- Pray for workers and churches who are going to unreached places, asking God to give them wisdom, protection, courage, and love.
- Pray that God would raise up local believers within unreached people groups to follow Jesus and share Him with others.

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:19–20)

HOW WE CAN PRAY FOR THE YAKUBUS

- » Pray for the total recovery and restoration of Joke's health.
- » Pray for the salvation of the Dagomba (staunch Muslims) ethnic tribe in Northern Ghana.
- » Pray for sustained church planting and intentional discipleship efforts in our generation.

- » Pray for unreached groups who still follow traditional or Islamic beliefs to encounter Jesus.
- » Pray for strong churches to be sent out as missionaries to nearby unreached peoples.
- » Pray for unity and boldness among believers to share their faith with love.

- » Pray for the small unreached groups in rural or isolated areas to hear the gospel clearly.
- » Pray for churches like Impacto, as they mobilize pastors to unreached parts of the world.
- » Pray for children and youth to grow up knowing God’s love and truth.

Most Spoken Language: Thai

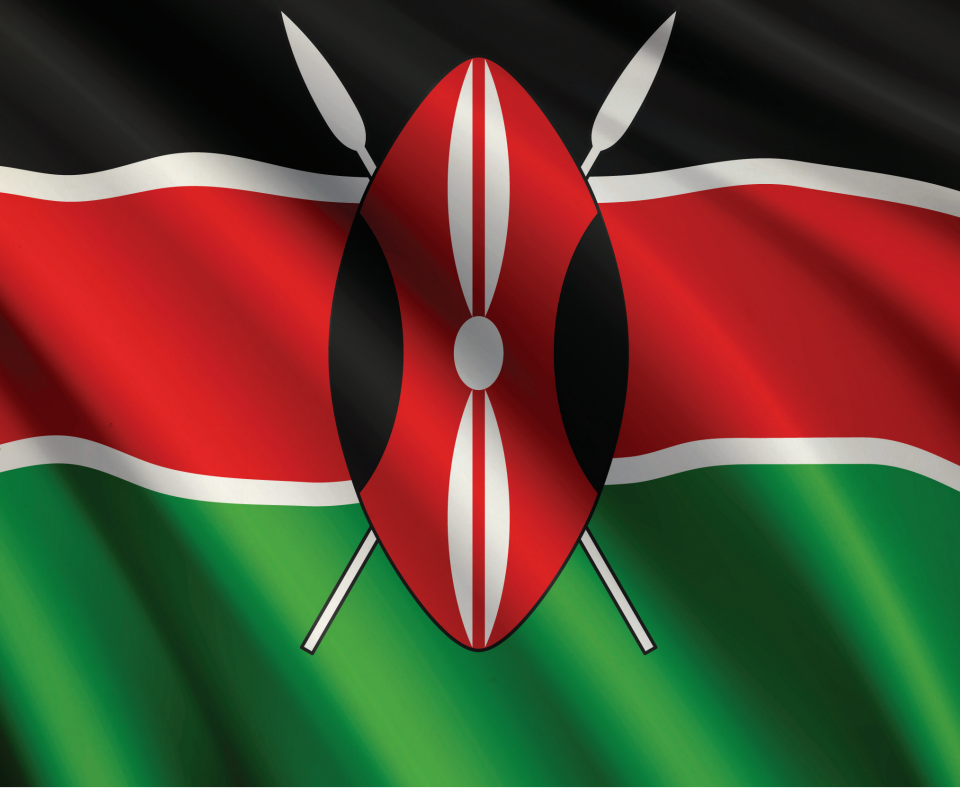
How to Say WELCOME: Yin dee ton rap (yin dee TAWN rap)
