LET YOUR KINGDOM COME, AND YOUR WILL BE DONE IN OUR CHURCH.

What would it look like to genuinely pray for God's kingdom to come and His will to be done in our church? We want to encourage you to receive, reflect, and pray over Scripture each week throughout the month of December. Take moments during the week to marinate in the Word and commune with God. He loves to hear His people pray. May His kingdom come, and His will be done in our church family!

WEEK 1 | ***Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Psalm 105:1–5; Psalm 85:6–9; Revelation 2:1–6.***

Pray that God makes us a worshiping church that praises His name with our lips and with our lives, living by His grace and for His glory. Pray that God will revive our sin-sick, weary hearts and keep us in or return us to His steadfast love. May we be a people who remember our first love in Christ and seek His presence continually.



WEEK 2 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over* **2 Timothy 3:14–17; Hebrews 4:12; Colossians 3:16; James 1:22.** Pray that God makes us a faithful church that loves, proclaims, and lives by His Word. Pray for more than just knowledge of the Scriptures but a true saturation in the Scriptures where the Spirit awakens our hearts to receive, believe, sing, pray, and share the Word.

WEEK 3 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over* **Hebrews 10:23–25; Philippians 2:1–5; John 13:34–35; Romans 12:9–21.** Pray that God makes us a church that loves one another, serves one another, and is marked by the fruit of the Spirit. Ask God to pour out His Spirit upon us in a way where our love for one another is inviting and contagious and shows a watching world the transforming power and grace of Jesus.

WEEK 4 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over* **Matthew 5:16; Matthew 9:35–38; Acts 1:8.** Pray that God makes us a church that shines His light everywhere we go and prays for workers to be sent out into the world to share the Good News of Jesus. Ask God to make us courageous and gracious, bold and loving as we show and share the gospel to those around us. May we be a church that spreads the love of Jesus at home and across the world.
