LET YOUR KINGDOM COME, AND YOUR WILL BE DONE IN MY CITY AS IT IS IN HEAVEN.

What would it look like to genuinely pray for God's kingdom to come and His will to be done in your city? We want to encourage you to receive, reflect, and pray over Scripture each week throughout the month of February. Take moments during the week to marinate in the Word and commune with God. He loves to hear His people pray. Not just for ourselves, but for others as well. May His kingdom come, and His will be done in our city! WEEK 1

Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Matthew 22:34–40

& Luke 10:25–37. When Jesus was asked which commandment was the greatest, His answer was to love God with all your heart and love your neighbor as yourself. God's love is at the very heart of seeing His kingdom come and His will done in our city as it is in heaven. Loving our neighbors as Christ has loved us has the power to radically transform our city. And who really is our neighbor? It's everyone. So, start with just one. Ask God for the power and compassion to love those that He has brought into your circle and for those who are outside your circle. May God's love flow to you and through you and spread throughout the city.

WEEK 2 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Jeremiah 29:4–7 & James 3:17–18.* Our city is full of various leaders in multiple positions and places: education, medicine, government, city services, business, law enforcement, and emergency responders. Pray that Christ would rule their hearts and that God's wisdom would prevail in their decision making and treatment of others that ultimately reflects God's kingdom and is for the good of our city. Use James 3:17 as a specific guide of how to pray for these leaders.

WEEK 3 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Micah 6:8 & Acts 2:42–47.* This week we want to pray for churches and ministries in our city that are proclaiming the gospel in word and deed. Pray for God's Spirit to be poured out upon them and for many to be reached in the name of Jesus. Pray for frontline ministries that are caring for the homeless, foster kids, those in prison, those with crisis pregnancies, those in need of food, those in need of mentoring and tutoring, those in need of medical attention, those affected by human trafficking and any other need the Spirit brings to mind.

WEEK 4 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Romans 12:16–21; Romans 14:17; 2 Thessalonians 3:16.* The kingdom of God is a place of righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit. When His kingdom comes, this is what it looks like. Pray for righteousness, peace, and joy in our city. Pray that God would push back the darkness, diminish crime, selfishness, and evil, and make a way for His love to invade our city in life transforming ways.
