LET YOUR KINGDOM COME, AND YOUR WILL BE DONE IN OUR STATE AND IN OUR COUNTRY AS IT IS IN HEAVEN.

What would it look like to genuinely pray for God's kingdom to come and His will to be done in our state and our country? We want to encourage you to receive, reflect, and pray over Scripture each week throughout the month of March. Take moments during the week to marinate in the Word and commune with God. He loves to hear His people pray. Not just for ourselves, but for others as well. May His kingdom come, and His will be done in our state and in our country!

WEEK 1 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over 1 Timothy 2:1–4;*

Proverbs 21:1; James 3:17. Throughout history, God has used many leaders—some believers, some not—to serve His purposes. As a church family, we pray faithfully for our state and national leaders—for grace to do God's will, that Christ would rule their hearts, for the Holy Spirit to guide their minds, that God's wisdom would prevail in their decision-making, and that their treatment of others would reflect God's kingdom for the good of our state and country. Using James 3:17 as a guide, pray for our state and national leaders.

WEEK 2 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over 2 Corinthians 7:14; Psalm 85:4–9; Nehemiah 1:5–9.* We pray for God's kingdom to come in our state and country and we say, "Let it begin in us!" Pray for believers all over the state and nation to humble themselves, to pray and seek God's face, and to turn from their wicked ways. Pray that for yourself and for our church. And may God truly heal our land, revive our hearts, and bring genuine transformation to our state and country.

WEEK 3 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Isaiah 1:16–17; Galatians 6:9–10; Zechariah 7:8–10.* Pray for God's justice and mercy to flow like a river. Pray for a growing love of the orphan, widow, sojourner, poor, and prisoner among us. Pray for the courage to do good, to seek God's justice, to correct oppression for those in need, and to do so with God's love and grace. Pray for effective laws in our state and country that will lead to human flourishing and for the church to live out the gospel in very practical, God-honoring ways.

WEEK 4 | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Psalm 133; Romans 12:16–21.* As we pray for God's kingdom to come in our state and country, let's pray that where there is division, God would bring unity. Where there is strife, God would bring peace. Where there is hatred, God would bring forgiveness. Where there is chaos and disorder, God would bring clarity and order. Where there is sin, God would bring repentance and grace. Let's pray for God to bring Up There, Down Here!
