**WEEK 1** | ***Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Mark 10:45; Mark 9:33–35; Philippians 2:5–7.***

## **WEEK 2** | *Spend this week receiving, reflecting, and praying over Galatians 5:13;*

Pray for those who volunteer and serve in so many different ministries of our church. Pray that God will grow them in grace and give them strength and joy as they serve our church family.
