What you can expect from Fellowship Church:

 - o Weekly: Weekly commitments such as mentoring, tutoring, etc.
 - o Ongoing: Non-committal, one-off projects that are flexible with schedules (delivering “hot” or freezer meals, small projects, etc.)
 - o Monthly: Happens once a month, or is a special event (yard work, holiday party, events, etc.)
